Small class sizes and academic support

Eynesbury College offers small class sizes, experienced teachers and close academic guidance to support students in preparation for university. A dedicated team of student support staff provide a range of services, information, learning support and counselling to students throughout their studies at Eynesbury.

Fast-track options and multiple intakes

With intakes in February, June and October, students can start their studies when it suits them best. It is possible to complete Foundation Studies or a Diploma in as little as 8 months and fast-track into the second year at Flinders University for most programs, subject to program and academic requirements.

All students have the opportunity to make new friendships and join monthly student events and activities, such as job search workshops, excursions, BBQs and various cultural celebrations.

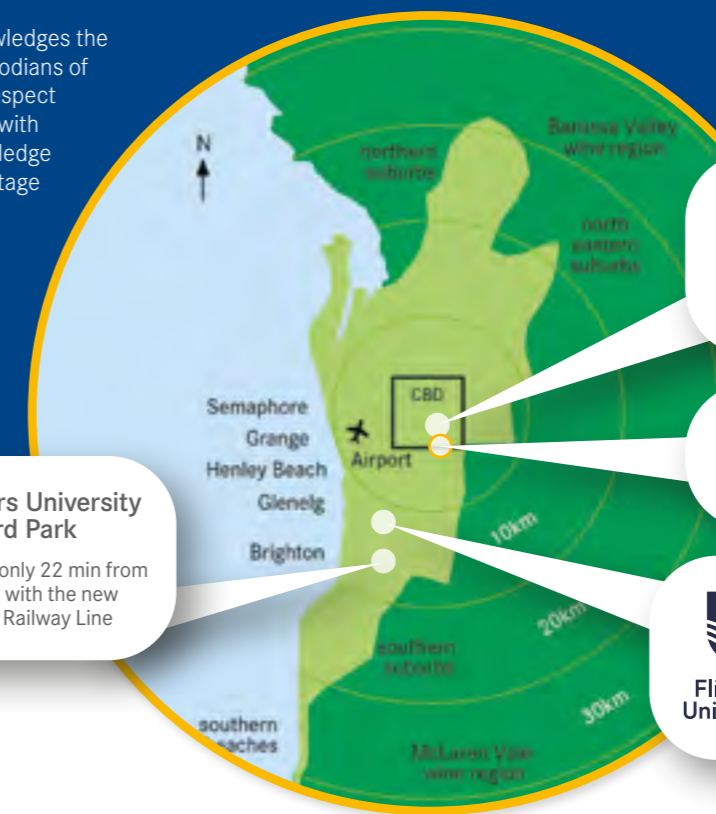

Cost of Living

A 2022 EIU Cost of Living survey found that Adelaide is **up to 12% more affordable than Sydney** and **up to 11% more affordable than Melbourne**. Saving money on rent, food and public transport means you have more money to spend on entertainment and exploring SA!

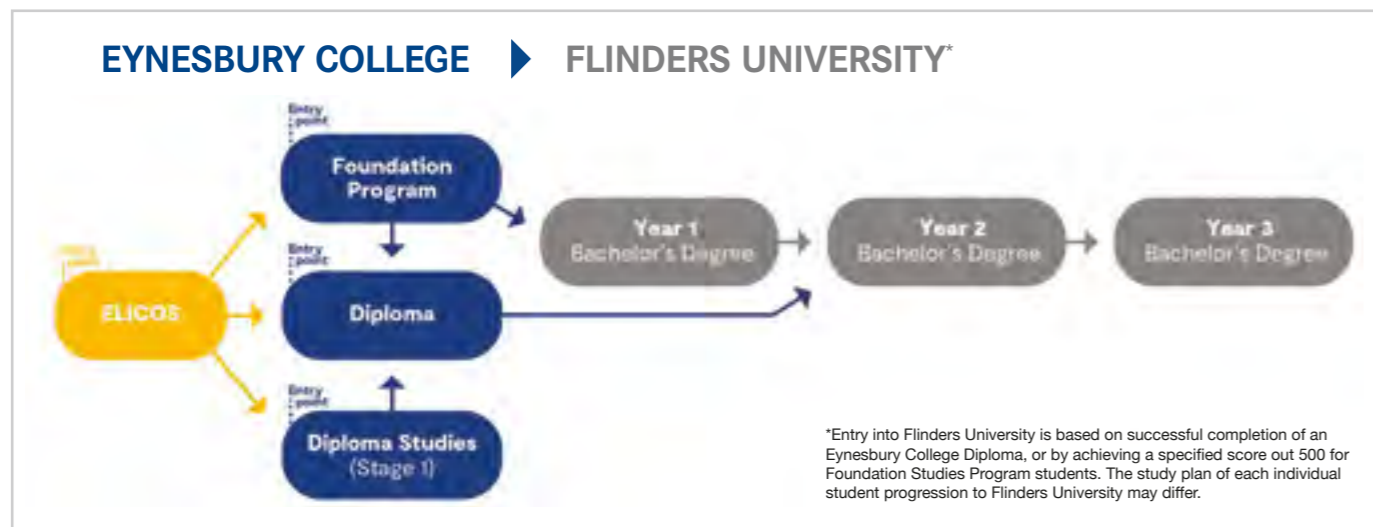

Our Programs

ELICOS

- Eynesbury College is a Flinders University approved English Language provider
- Gain entry to undergraduate or postgraduate degrees at Flinders University without sitting an IELTS test
- Students can expect their IELTS to improve 0.5 for each 10 week block of successful study

Foundation Studies Program

- Foundation Studies Program (FSP) is an 8 or 12 month program, which prepares international students for entry into first year of undergraduate study, or an Eynesbury Diploma
- Ability to package with most undergraduate programs at Flinders University

Homestay

Homestay accommodation gives you the opportunity to live with a local family in their home. You'll get to use English in everyday situations and experience the Australian lifestyle. All homestay hosts have met safety and welfare requirements.

-  A\$340 per week (all meals included, except lunch on week days)
A\$250 per week (cook your own meals)*
-  Your own fully furnished bedroom
-  Shared bathroom

* Students under 18 must take the meals included option





Independent accommodation

Independent rental can be a great option once you know your way around Adelaide. It can also be less expensive, particularly if you're sharing with other people.

Visit www.realestate.com.au and select 'rent'.

Be careful that you fully understand the terms of an independent rental contract. This type of accommodation is not arranged by Eynesbury. We do not recommend independent rental unless you're already living in Adelaide and feel confident to find your own accommodation.

-  A\$300+ per week for 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom.
A\$600+ for a larger house.
-  Most rental properties are not furnished. You will need to buy furniture, cutlery, crockery, bed linen, towels and electrical equipment. You will also need to cover the cost of the electricity, gas and water for the house, plus your own food costs and public transport (if in suburban area).

For independent rental the bond is lodged with the State Government and will be reimbursed when you move out, provided there is no damage to the property and no outstanding rent or bills. You also need to give a minimum amount of notice if you decide to leave your accommodation. *Prices are current at the time of printing and may be subject to change.
